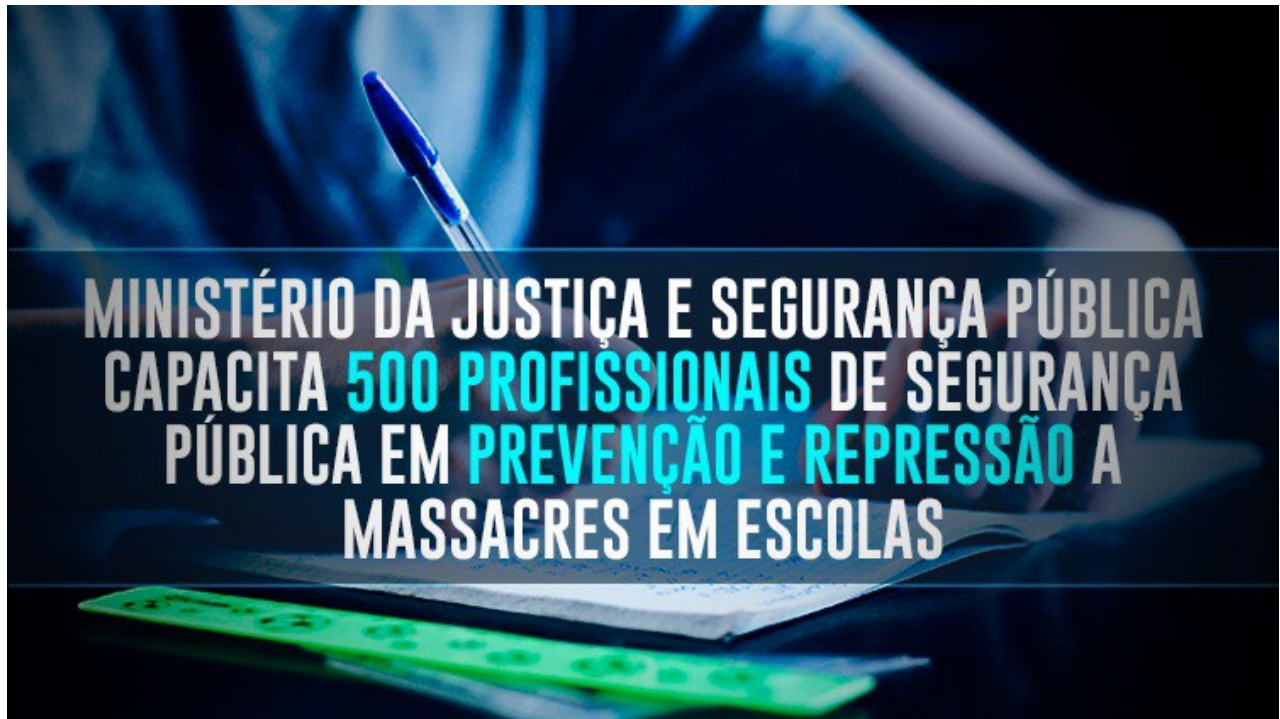


Ministry of Justice and Public Security trains 500 public safety professionals in preventing and suppressing massacres in schools

Action, carried out in partnership with the U.S. government, was exclusive to Brazilian civil intelligence police

Brasília, 07/15/2021 - The Ministry of Justice and Public Security (MJSP), in partnership with the United States Department of Diplomatic Security, promoted, on July 14 and 15, the seminar on "Identification, Analysis and Mitigation of Threats". The initiative presented techniques for preventing and suppressing attacks in Brazilian schools

for 500 civilian police officers from intelligence and investigation units across the country.

The course lasted four hours a day and was broadcast on the U.S. government's online platform. On the last day there was a lecture with representatives of Facebook and Whatsapp, on procedures for using the platforms in investigative processes.

The training was taught by U.S. representatives such as Russell Palarea, a psychologist specializing in internal threat assessment; and Kendall Donabue, head of the State Department's Intelligence and Protection Investigation Division.

The seminar was articulated by the National Secretariat of Public Security (SENAP) of the MJSP and has the organization of the Regional Security Office of the Diplomatic Mission of São Paulo.

Support

Last May, the Ministry of Justice and Public Security played a key role in dissolving threats of attack in schools in the country. The first was in Rio de Janeiro on May 6. After being triggered by the Civil Police of Rio de Janeiro, teams from the Cyber Operations Laboratory of the Secretariat of Integrated Operations (Seopi) identified that the threat came from the city of Cabo Frio (RJ). With the information passed on by the Ministry team, the state Civil Police was able to identify and apprehend the suspected teenager, who would have disclosed the action on their social networks.

Already on May 21, the team of the Ministry of Justice and Public Security passed on information to the Civil Police of the Federal District about a young woman planning an attack on a school in the region. After being triggered by the U.S. Embassy, the MJSP Cyber Operations Laboratory identified that the threats came from a 19-year-old girl. She was arrested and released after giving testimony. The young woman planned to execute the crime on the return of classrooms, scheduled for the second half of this year.
